# Resources

- **NYC Employee Retention Grant**

- **CLOSES Friday, April 3rd at 5:00pm**

- This program is available to New York City businesses with one to four employees that can demonstrate at least a 25% decrease in revenue as a result of COVID-19. Eligible businesses will receive a grant covering up to 40% of their payroll for two months. Businesses can access up to \$27,000.

- **NYC Small Business Continuity Loan**

- NYC businesses with fewer than 100 employees who have seen sales decreases of 25% or more will be eligible to apply for zero interest loans of up to \$75,000 to help ensure business continuity.
